- 1. Welcome and Opening of the Extraordinary General Meeting (Joselito Benitez, PAC Vice-President)

Mr. Benitez, PAC Vice-President, welcomed the participants to the Extraordinary General Meeting. The first order of business was to establish that the Statute provisions were met for the Extraordinary General meeting decisions to be valid including: meeting quorum, meeting presided over by the Vice-President of PAC, notice to members of agenda and the communication of date/venue 15 days in advance. Mr. Benitez then declared the opening of the Extraordinary General Meeting.

He then briefly discussed the sole agenda item of the meeting, which was the appointment of an external Auditor. As background, the annual General Assembly in May 2024 was unable to reappoint the incumbent external Auditor as he announced that he would not be renewing his term at the actual meeting. As this appointment needs to be approved by the members of the General Assembly, the parish is obliged to hold an Extraordinary General Meeting in order to fulfil our obligations under the Statutes.

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
Confirmation, tomorrow morning with Bishop Charles 10h00
